Main rule changes for 2020:-

1. U7's & U8's can have up to 30 registered players; 9's upwards will continue to be 25 max.
2. 12.4 Any player who has been registered before on SportsTG must go to a different Club/League through the transfer process regardless of which League or how long ago it was since they played.
3. 14.1 The closing date for transfers for U12s (Year 7) and above shall be 30th September for those beginning in March.
4. 23.10 The maximum score to be published by the League will be 50 points has been removed, meaning the full score, for U12's and above, will be used.
5. 23.10.1 The top four teams of each division must have played each other home and away, subject to the number of teams within the division.
6. 24.2.1 Competitive age groups must log the score online using LeagueNet (SportsTG Passport and access required). Either team can do it, but it is classed as the HOME team's responsibility. Both teams should also input information (players/volunteers) from the Matchday Information Sheet into LeagueNet.
7. 24.2.2 Primary age groups should enter the information (players/volunteers) from the Matchday Information Sheet into LeagueNet. Teams should also enter the results to prove the game has been played – these will not be published. At U9s and below it is acceptable to put 1-1 rather than an actual score.
8. Kick-off times for matches and duration of the various age groups will be as follows. Sunday 10.30am 40 minutes in a day Under 6s (Year 1 only) start after Easter  
Sunday 10.30am 40 minutes in a day Under 7s (Year 1&2)  
Sunday 10.30am 40 minutes in a day Under 8s (Year 3)  
Sunday 11.00am 40 minutes in a day Under 9s (Year 4)  
Saturday 12.30am 40 minutes in a day Under 10s (Year 5)  
Saturday 10.30pm 40 minutes Under 12s (Year 7)  
Sunday 10.30am 50 minutes Under 14s (Year 9)

9. 25.1.1 Teams cannot postpone or choose to forfeit both games to the same team. A refusal to play a particular team will result in all other fixtures being suspended until the game is played, and the offending team fined as though they had forfeit the game.
10. Discipline points have been brought in for team officials now as well....
